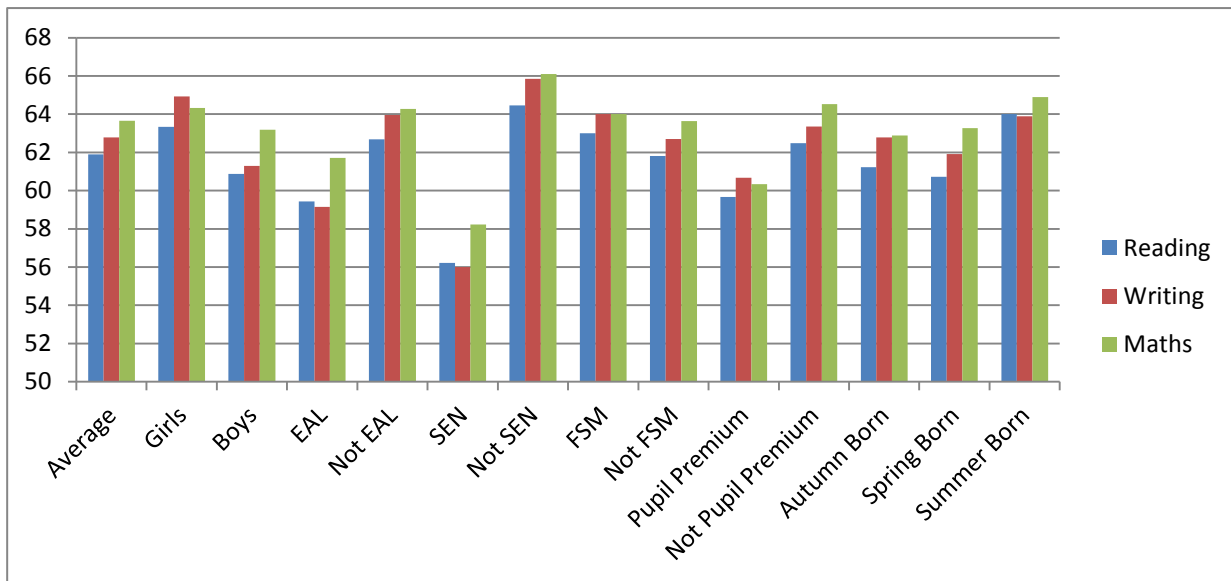
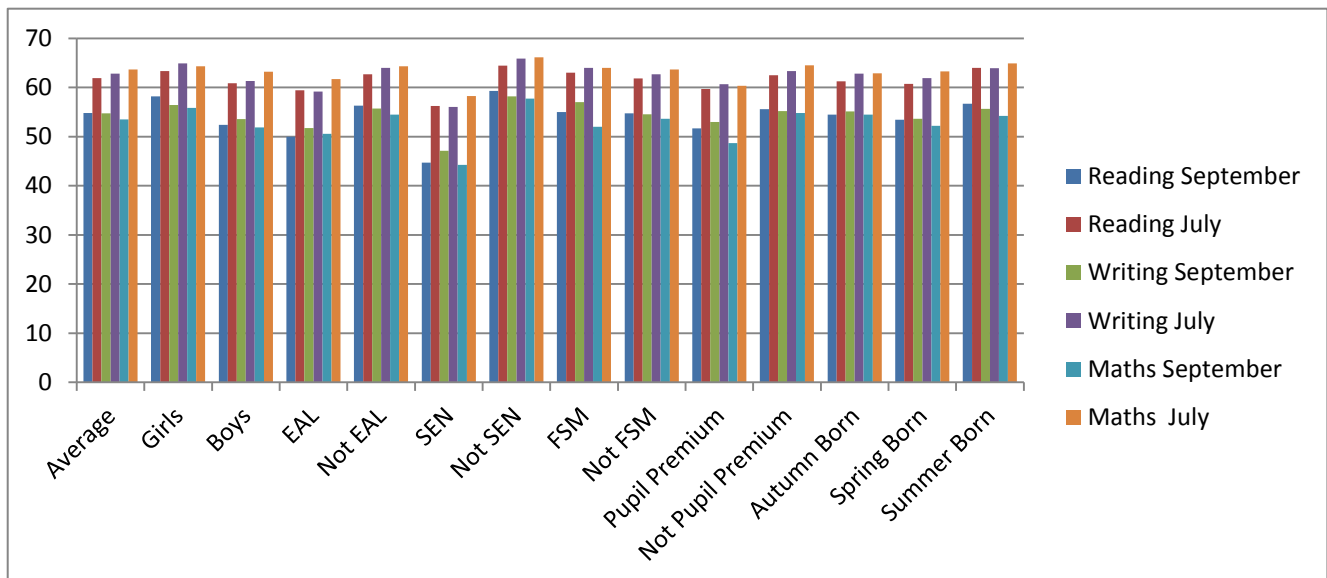


## Year 6 Attainment



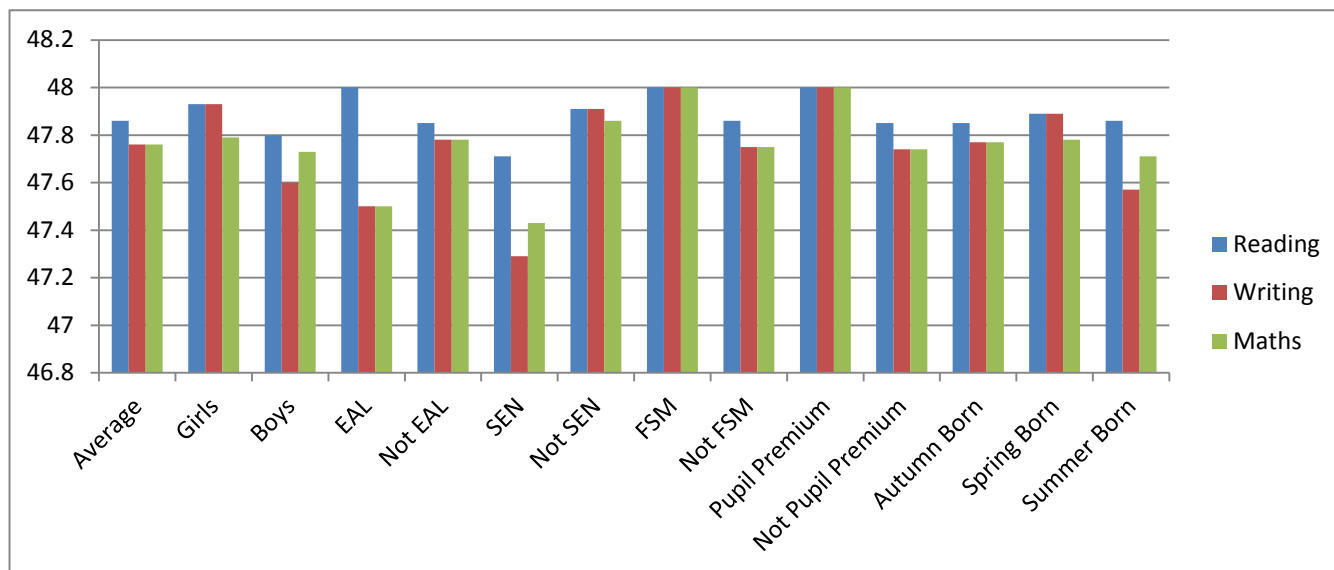

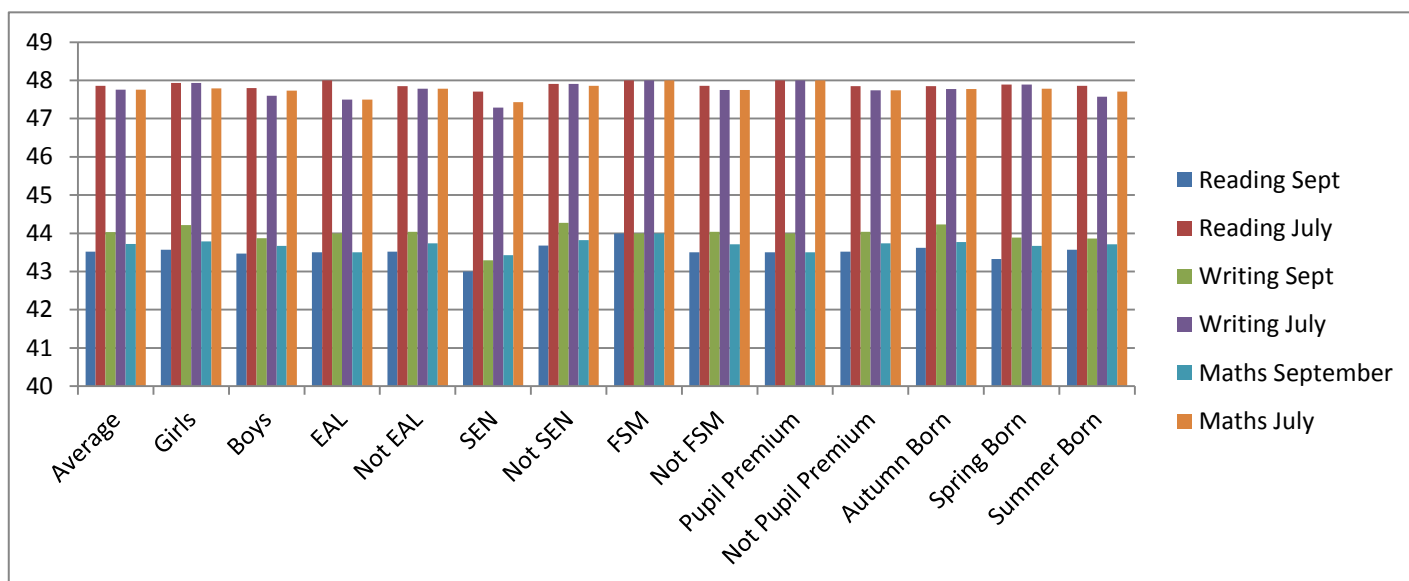

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## Year 5 Attainment

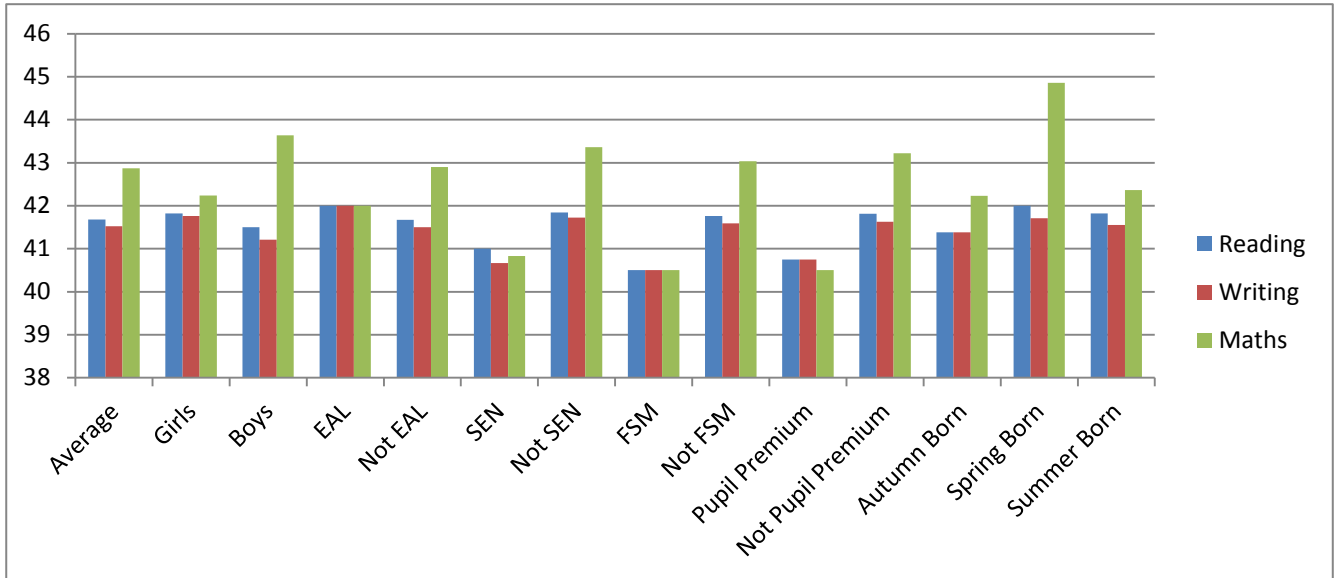

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## Year 3 Attainment



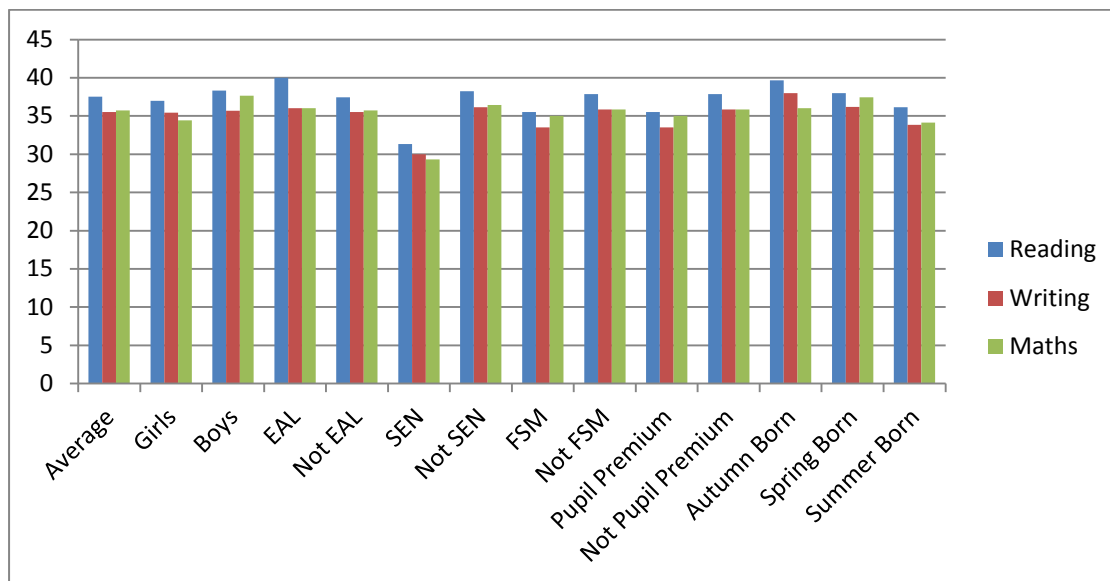

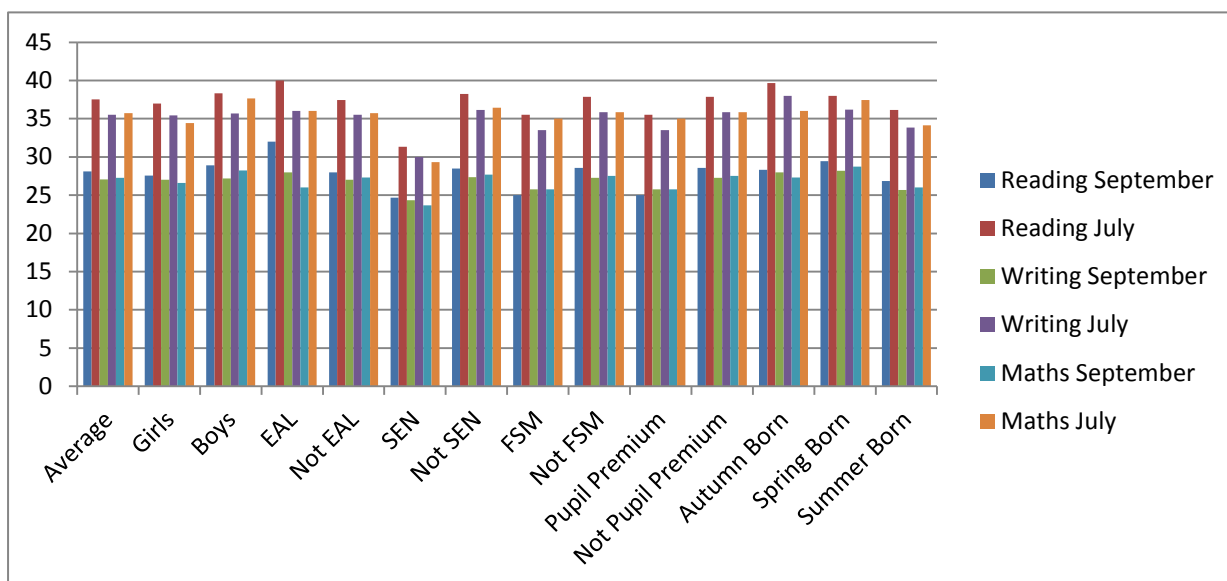
In year 3 the PP pupils achieved well. The scale of the graph makes the progress look dramatic, but it is actually in keeping with the other years.

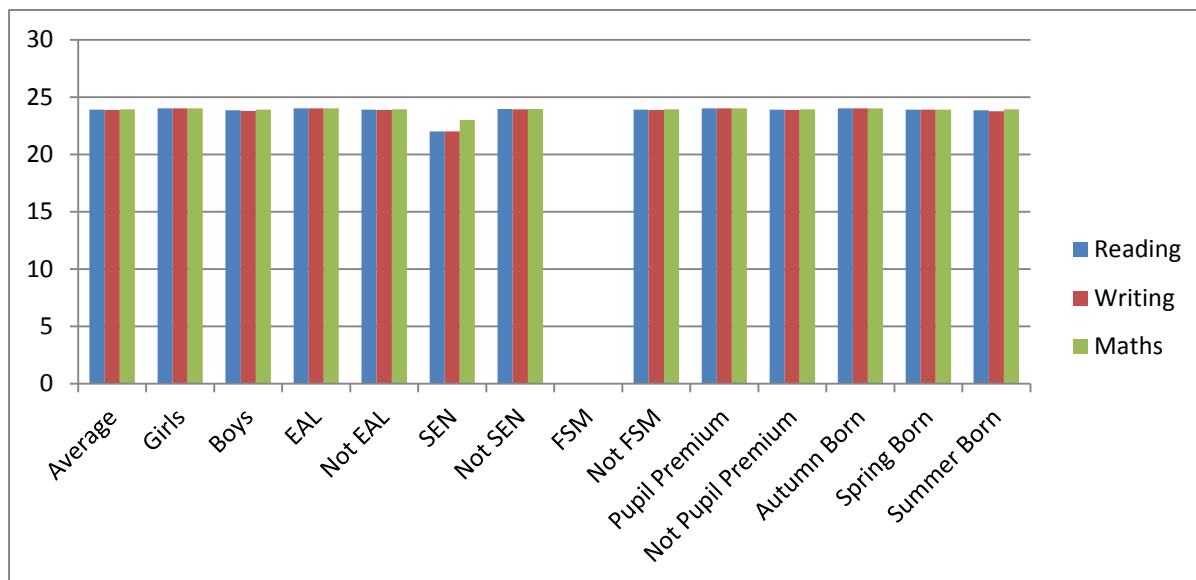


In Year 2 the children who are entitled to Pupil Premium achieved well. Their lowest subject was writing which will be a target in year 2.

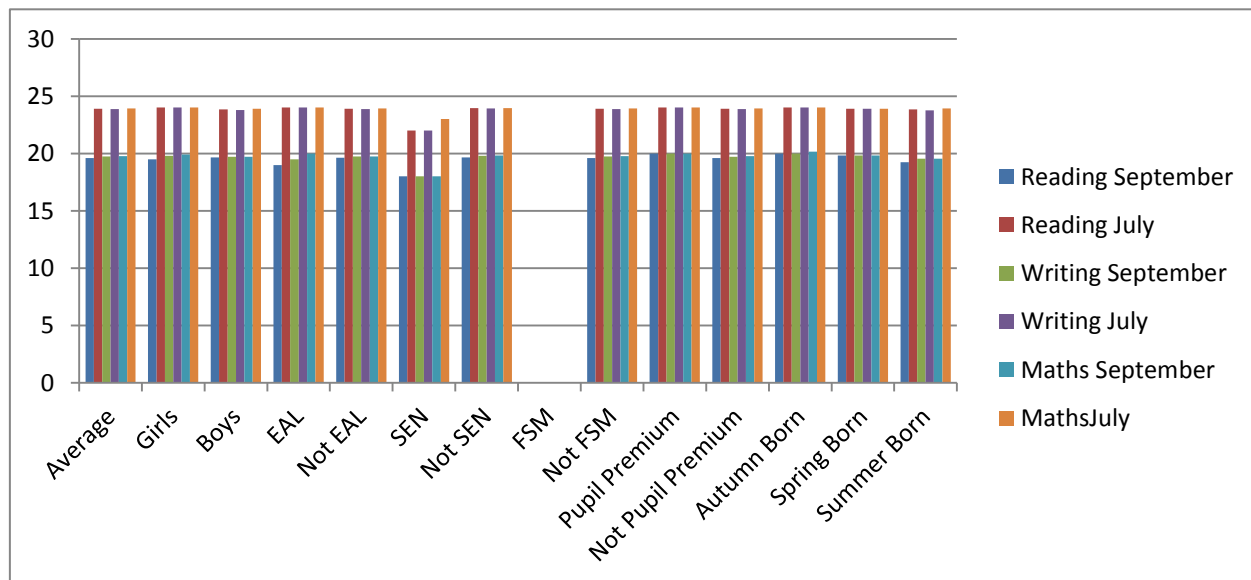
